TechBridge breaks the cycle of generational poverty through the innovative use of technology to transform nonprofit and community impact.

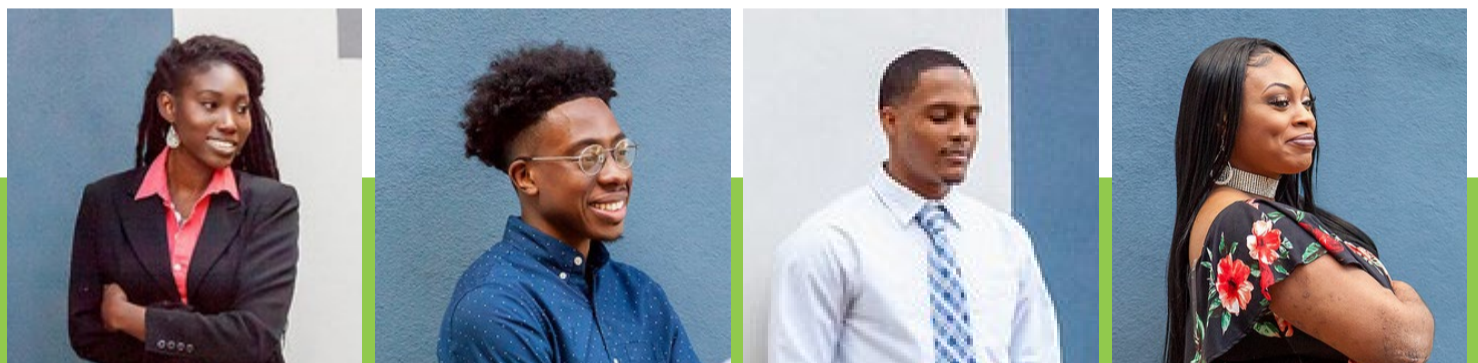


TechBridge and Goodwill of North Georgia with input from area technology employers developed a free, innovative 16-week technology career program to train a diverse set of students including recent high school graduates with limited access and opportunity to traditional universities, military veterans, and career changers for high-paying jobs in Atlanta’s technology sector.

Over half of the students secured jobs by the date of graduation with an average wage increase of 91%!

Through the innovative use of technology, the program positively impacts the students’ lives and gives back to the local communities through a skilled workforce focused on a successful future for themselves and their communities.

Through collaboration with key Atlanta business partners such as Accenture, Elavon, Graphic Packaging International, Insight, NCR, Southern Company and others, our first cohort was a success and our students have already started their path to career success.



Our goal is to raise \$25,000 between now and the end of 2018 and secure 25 jobs for our current students.

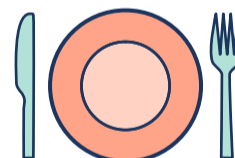

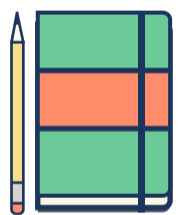
